EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MESSAGE

Dear Friends,

This year was a big one for Project Focus, full of growth, partnership, and real momentum.

For more than a decade, we've been focused on creating pathways for individuals with developmental disabilities to learn, build independence, and fully participate in their community. This past year, that commitment took a meaningful step forward with the launch of Focus Day School and our Focus Workforce Readiness Programs. Adding a private elementary program for students in grades 3–6 with developmental disabilities, alongside workforce programming for individuals 18 and older, reflects our commitment to serving this population at every stage of life.

These initiatives reinforce our belief in meeting families earlier, surrounding students with support, and building a continuum of services that grows with them into adulthood. It strengthens our ability to walk alongside individuals and their families from childhood through independence within one connected Focus ecosystem.

Across all of our programs, we saw continued progress. Focus Academy remained a thriving tuition-free charter school. Focus Forward expanded opportunities for young adults to develop life skills, job readiness, and confidence in the community. At the same time, we began laying the groundwork for what comes next, the vision of our founders and the development of an integrated campus that brings education, workforce training, and long-term support together in one place. Partnerships like our collaboration with MOSI opened doors to hands-on learning and real-world workforce experiences, and events like the Tampa Glow Row helped deepen our connection to the broader community.

Just as important has been the growth of our leadership and governance. The formation of our first Advisory Council and Young Professionals Advisory Board brought new voices, expertise, and energy to our mission, strengthening the foundation for where we are headed.



What we're building at Project Focus is more than programs, it's a community of opportunity, support, and belonging. And we're just getting started.

OUR STORY

In 2012, a small group of parents of children with special needs were struggling to find schools that made their children feel valued, supported, and prepared for success. By partnering with academic and therapeutic professionals, the dream of Focus Academy became a reality in the heart of Temple Terrace, Florida.

What began as a flagship program, supported by a thoughtfully developed philosophical approach, has grown into the foundation that permeates all Focus programs and entities. As students advanced, so did the founders' commitment to supporting them, not only in the classroom, but throughout their transition into adulthood.

In 2018, Project Focus was established to strengthen, support, and expand both existing and future initiatives.

Today, that mission thrives on through:

- Focus Academy (Charter School)
- Focus Café
- Focus Forward (Adult Day Program)
- Focus Employment Training
(Vocational Rehabilitation Program)
- Focus Day School (Private School)

Together, these programs form a comprehensive continuum of support serving students, adults, and our broader community with dedication, vision, and purpose.

Since 2013 the Focus programs have served hundreds of young people with developmental disabilities and their families across the Tampa Bay Region.

FOCUS DAY SCHOOL OPENS ITS DOORS

Building a Strong Foundation for Lifelong Success

In August 2025, Project Focus provided startup funding to launch Focus Day School (FDS), a private, nonprofit 501(c)(3) currently serving students in grades 3–6 with developmental and learning disabilities.

FDS was created to support students who applied to Focus Academy but did not meet the charter school's eligibility requirements yet clearly needed additional academic support. Built on the proven Focus approach, the school expands grade levels each year to serve more students in need.

Focus Day School is an approved provider for Step Up For Students and delivers the same high standard of excellence as its flagship school.



FOCUS EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PROGRAM

With the generous financial support of Project Focus, the Vocational Rehabilitation Program was developed. The program was approved in 2024 and launched in 2025 with its first Work Readiness Training Program. Designed specifically for individuals with developmental and learning disabilities, the program equips students and young adults with essential workplace skills through structured training, personalized support, and hands-on learning.

Future expansion will include On-the-Job Training and Job Coaching, helping participants move confidently toward meaningful employment and long-term career success.



OUR PROGRAMS



Focus Academy is a tuition-free Florida public charter school serving grades 6-12 and a Transition Program for ages 18-22. We provide students diagnosed with cognitive and developmental challenges with a community that supports feelings of value, connection, and lifetime success. Our innovative and integrated teaching approach equips students with special needs in the Tampa Bay area with the necessary skills to live purposeful and enriched lives.

Focus Day School is a private, non-profit program dedicated to empowering young students with learning and/or developmental disabilities. Building on the success of the innovative Focus Academy Charter School, our school was founded with the understanding that early intervention and specialized education are key to helping students thrive.

Focus Forward is a unique Adult Day Training Life Skills Development 3 provider. Our program is geared towards the needs of young adults with disabilities. As our current cohort of 22 to 30-year-olds ages up, we will expand to serve more ages.

Focus Café is a working cafe within the Temple Terrace Recreation Center, which provides real-world employment training experiences for Focus Academy Transition Program students during the school year and for Focus Forward Clients during the summer months.

in learning job readiness skills and increased independence.
